Is my child ready for kindergarten?

Physically

- Exhibits fine motor skills
(holds pencil, traces shapes, buttons shirt, works zippers.)
- Exhibits motor coordination
(puts on own jacket, rides a bike with training wheels, hops, skips)
- Manages bathroom needs alone, washes hands and open and close doors



Socially

- Knows personal information (first and last name, age, gender)
- Uses "please" and "thank you"
- Recognizes authority figures
- Follows simple directions
- Uses eating utensils
- Plays and shares well with others

Academically (pre-reading skills)

- Can retell a simple story
- Writes and recognizes letters in name
- Speaks in complete sentences of 5-6 words
- Counts to ten



What can I do to help my child succeed in kindergarten?



- Read to and with your child **OFTEN!**
- Practice knowing shapes and colors.
- Practice writing name and letters with both upper and lower case. Example Amber
- Practice writing 0-10 and counting objects one to ten
